

Fabulous keepsake cards that are simple to make but look so stunning when made up and will WOW the recipient.




For best results print sheets 1 to 3 onto photo paper or good quality cardstock and sheets 5 & 6 onto good quality paper. For a pretty lining print sheet 4 onto the reverse of sheets 5 & 6













Before cutting out score each of the fold lines as per these diagrams.

Follow the extra diagram on the left for the fold lines on sheet 1

Note the red partial score lines.

Cut on the blue lines.

Fold and crease all the score lines using a bone folder.

Punch small holes where marked on sheets 2 & 3

The inside back from sheet one will look like this when you have scored and folded as above

Turn over and add adhesive in the area where marked in red on the photo, but make sure not to add any to the back of the pop out pieces



Take the outer back from sheet 2 and mountain fold on all the score lines



Turn over and adhere the inner back in place, making sure the top edges are aligned and the right and left edges line up with the score lines on the reverse of the outer back



Pull the pop up pieces out and add adhesive to the front of them, where marked in red on the photo



Adhere the pop up layer to the the pop up pieces, making sure it sits centrally and is aligned along the bottom edge


Your card will now look like this from the front



Your card will now look like this from the side, with the pop up layer only attached to the pop up pieces and sitting slightly back from the front of the layer below it



Push upwards on the pop up layer so it and the layer below it folds along it's central score line. Fold in the tabs at the side along the score lines.





Take the front layer from sheet one, tun over and fold in the tabs along the score lines



Align and adhere on the left hand side, making sure the side and bottom edges are aligned.









Fold the front open, note that the hook for the rubber band and the flap will be free within the card.

Add adhesive to the flap marked in red on the photo.

Fold the front over and adhere the top of the middle section of the front to the adhesive we added above. The fold line of the flap will align with the top of the middle section of the front. (the reverse of the edge marked in red on the photo)

Open the right hand section of the front and remove the carrier tape from the area we added adhesive to earlier (marked in red on the photo)

Fold the front back down making sure that all edges are aligned.

Please note - the front section is adhered in these 3 stages to make it easier to make sure that all edges are aligned correctly



It is easier to add the decoupage to the front layer now before installing the rubber band mechanism. As the decoupage is separate you can choose what and where to add it, or make it differently every time

Add the rubber band slipping it onto




the hooks in the base of your card. I used thin shirring elastic in black so you can see it in the photo. Make sure the elastic is just long enough so it doesn't stretch when the card is opened but will stretch on collapsing the card. My elastic measured approx 5.5 inch in width (doubled) before installing it. Adding a twist to



the band will allow you to fine tune it

Gently press on the front of your card until it is fully folded and flat and will slip into it's matching envelope. I printed the coordinating backing paper onto the reverse of my envelope for a pretty lining








I added a tag and beads hung from a bow onto the back of my card












