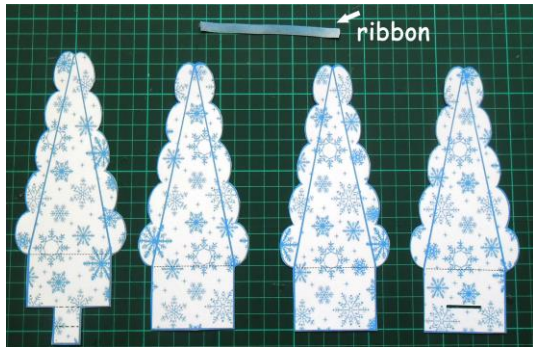


How to make a Christmas tree box

Print out the sheet you wish to use onto medium weight card (about 180gsm) or photo paper. For dark colours or black use card as it does not smudge like photo paper.

Cut out all the pieces see picture 1

2. Cut out the slot, see picture 2
3. Fold back the flap and glue (see picture 3)
4. Score and fold on the solid and dotted lines. Fold the scalloped edges forwards. (See picture 2)

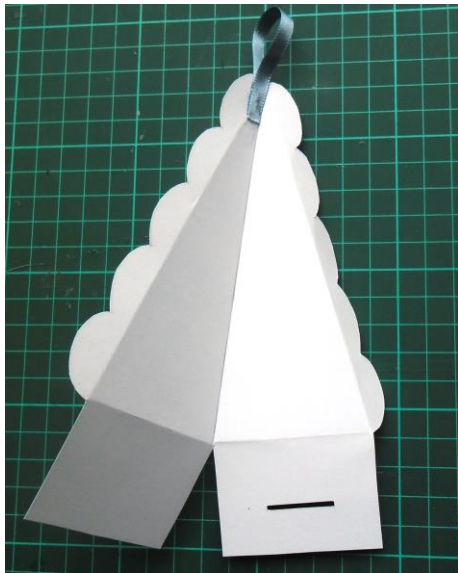

5. Use a liquid glue which can be moved around a bit to glue the scalloped edges together, (see picture 4).
6. Make sure that you have the piece with the slot opposite the piece with the flap so your box will close properly. (see picture 6)

7. If you want to add a ribbon turn your box over and glue it in place (see picture 5).

If you put a heavy item in the box you may need to secure the bottom opening with a small piece of sticky tape.
