Fabulous keepsake cards that are simple to make but look so stunning when made up and will WOW the recipient.



For best results print sheets 1 to 4 onto photo paper or good quality cardstock and sheets 6 & 7 onto good quality paper. For a pretty lining print sheet 6 onto the reverse of sheets 6 & 7









Please read the instructions all the way through before starting to make up.

Before cutting out score each of the fold lines as per these diagrams. Mountain fold the red lines and valley fold the blue lines

Fold and crease all the score lines using a bone folder. When cutting out I suggest you mark the back of the front and back outer pieces so you know which is which.

Add dst to the front where marked in blue on the left photo and thin foam pads to the decoupage areas where marked in orange on the left photo. Once the front has been folded and creased it will look like the right photo

... and like this from the bottom

Adhere the right outer front to the dst on the right of the front.

The top & bottom will line up as will the snow.



Repeat on the left side adding the left outer front. You will now have one long piece with the front in the middle and the outer fronts to the left and right.



Turn over and adhere the central part of the back to the reverse of the front, lining up the edges. I used glue stick to give me wriggle room to position it



Once you are happy with the placement of the back fold down and adhere the 2 sides.

Again I used glue stick for mine.



Adhere the left and right outer backs using glue stick. There will be a small white area showing at the fold but this is intentional to reduce thickness and make folding easier. Refold along each of the fold lines and burnish using a bone folder.









Add the tree and character decoupage to the foam pads we added earlier. As these overhang the sides they are only attached on one side. The rest of the decoupage is separate and you can choose where or if to use it. Take care not to make your card too deep though or it won't fit into it's envelope.

I added one of the greetings as a swing tag, hanging on the back

Your card will look like this when you push in the sides to close the card.

Make up the matching envelope. The instructions are on the sheets

Score cut out and fold the matching gift tag



Your Finished Card when displayed will be 10.5" wide x 1.5" deep x 6" tall and when closed will be 7.5" wide x 6" tall








