

Word Art Assembly Instructions

Word Art can be challenging to align to a card or scrapbook page. Using a transfer method with mesh drywall tape make transferring the wording to your paper project as easy as using transfer paper for vinyl alignment.

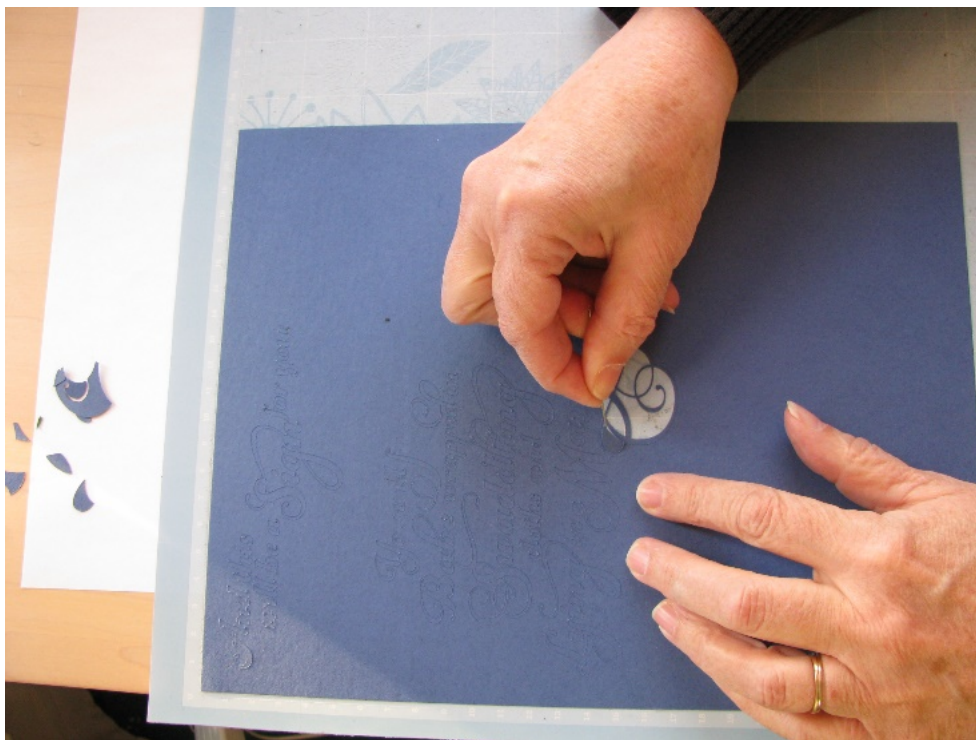

At the end of this document I have included some pictures of me doing this method in another project.

Use mesh drywall tape method to layer the words to the background. This makes it easy to line up the objects. When this layer is completed it can be glued to the card base.

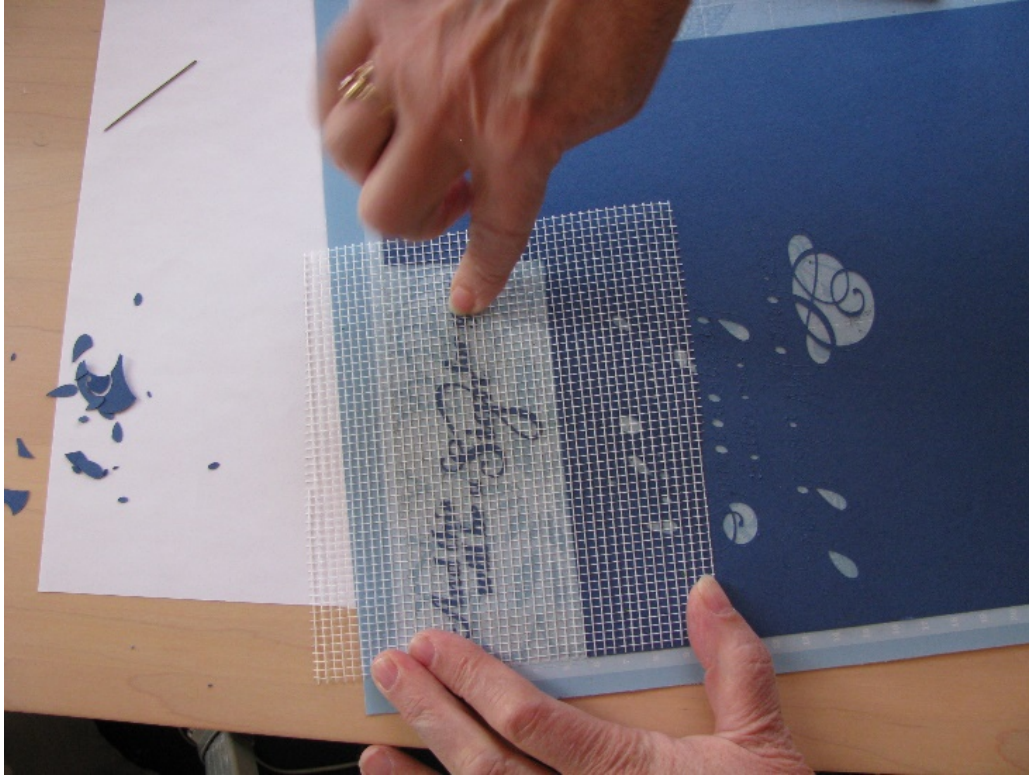


Carefully take out all open areas of the letters.

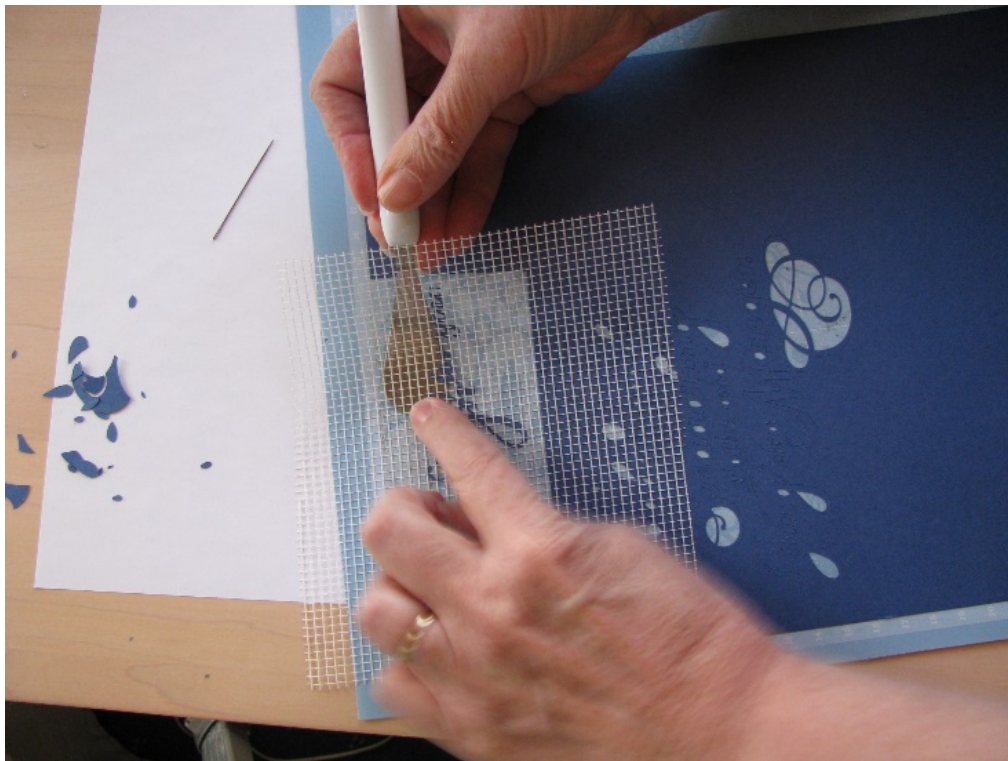


Remove the outer portion so the words remain on the mat.





Cover the words with the mesh wallboard tape.



Lift the letters off the mat so the stick to the mesh.

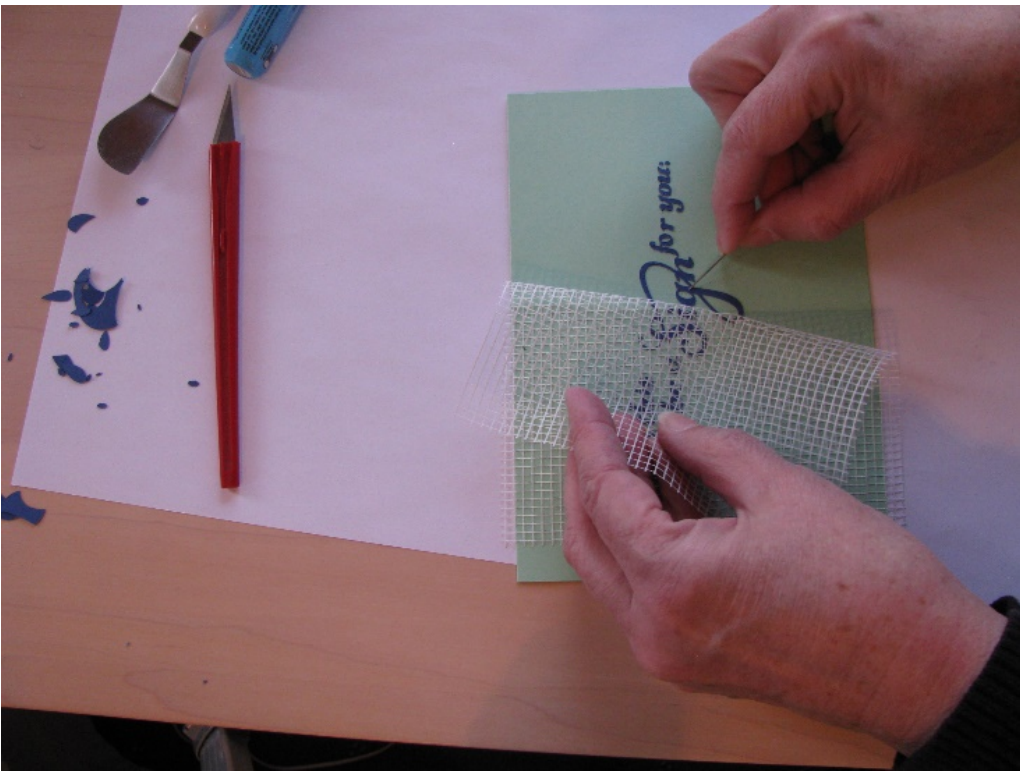


Turn over and apply adhesive glue. I use ZIG Memory system.





Line up the words on the card or wordart layer.



Carefully peel the mesh off the words and let dry.
