

General Christmas Ornament

Assembly instructions using Let It Snow Christmas Ornament

The ornament size is less than 4.5 inches. It would make a great gifts and can be attached to the front of a card. Cutting from heavy card stock or double cutting and using spray adhesive to laminate the pieces together makes a sturdy ornament. It can be made with just one side or reverse the pieces for the back. This is an important step since the design was intended for just one side.

The example in the photo was created with the following materials:



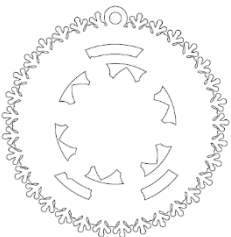
Cut two from metallic card stock with one reflected for the back. These are two separate pieces, circle and snowflake. Cut four from white card stock and glue two together using spray adhesive making two of each for the front and back layer.



Cut one from glitter card stock. Reverse the image and cut one from glitter card stock for the back. Cut four from white card stock and glue two together using spray adhesive. This makes two layers for front and back. Reverse the two for the back if not using a solid color.



This is an **optional piece** and was not used in the example. It provides a colored background layer for the words and snowflake. Cut only two



Cut two from white card stock and glue together using spray adhesive for the central core.

Assemble layers in order starting with the first snowflake layer. This will assure that the layers can use the spray adhesive on the back of each layer. Finish off with a ribbon to hang the ornament.
