

Fabulous keepsake cards that are simple to make but look so stunning when made up and will WOW the recipient.



For best results print sheets 1 to 3 onto photo paper or good quality cardstock and sheets 5 & 6 onto good quality paper. For a pretty lining print sheet 4 onto the reverse of sheets 1, 2, 5 & 6



Before cutting out score each of the fold lines as per these diagrams. Note the red partial score lines and cut on the blue lines. Fold and crease all the score lines using a bone folder



Adhere the flap and back panels in place and add decoupage where wished.

Add double sided tape to one of the pieces where marked in red on the photo making sure you avoid the hole and elastic slot



Fold in all the tabs.
Remove the carrier from
the elastic slot pieces as
marked in red on the photo



Line up the pieces and adhere together



Open the box and attach a rubber band to the hooks



Turn upside down and join the 2 pairs of base pieces using the dst we added earlier



Your card will now look like this from above.



Fold and crease the cross bars. Add dst where marked in red on the top photo

They will be added to the box as per the boom photo



Add the cross pieces adhering a little below top and so the arms butt against the front and the back of th box



Your card will now look like this



To close your card squish it with the elastic band running left to right. Gently start to fold in the 2 base pieces. Your card will try to resist ... that's the pop up mechanism working lol



Continue the squish it till it's completely flat





Now comes the fun bit .... adding the decoupage! Adhere it to the front and the back of the cross bars



Your decoupage can come 'out of the box, but squish your card to make sure they are mostly within the area of the flaps



I added some small decoupage on clear acetate strips so they will 'float' when the card pops up. I squished the card to make sure they stayed within the flaps area when the card is flattened

Make up the matching envelope using the instructions on the sheets. You can pu your card in with the front flaps up or down ... I chose to put mine in with the flaps down.



I added decoupage on clear acetate and bows to my card. The decoupage is separate so you can make it differently every time!



There's a writing panel on the back of your card



The base of your box card is totally finished too!
