Aperture Card Kit

This card is quick and very easy to make but the end result can be stunning!! This will depend on what you choose to use behind the aperture.

Background Papers, Glitter Paper, Mirror board, Acetate, Lace, Material, Ribbon, in fact anything you think would look good will 'make' this card.

OKso lets make it!

- 1. Cut out the topper, sentiments, and the aperture area as indicated.
- 2. Assemble any ribbons or extras you are going to use.



3. You now need to put whatever you've chosen behind the aperture area. Make sure the edges are stuck down well. What you use is your choice. Use a colour that 'blends' in or a colour that contrasts to the rest of the card top.



- 4. Place your topper on your card base, either directly or building it up with background papers till your happy.
- 5. Once your card base is done, add the insert
- 6. Embellish to your liking using foam pads using the item given and the sentiment pieces. Add ribbons, glitter, foil, whatever you choose to finish your card.
