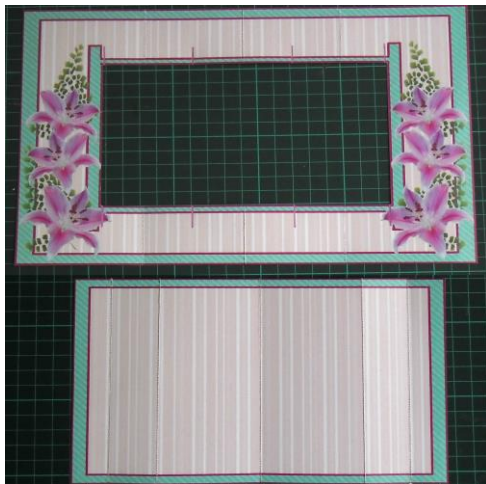


## Double concertina cards

### Instructions

1. Print the main card, inside concertina, oval layers and front and back sheets onto photo paper for best results.
2. Cut out all the parts. When cutting out the oval shapes and shapes for front make sure you cut off the black lines, they are only there to show you where the edges are.

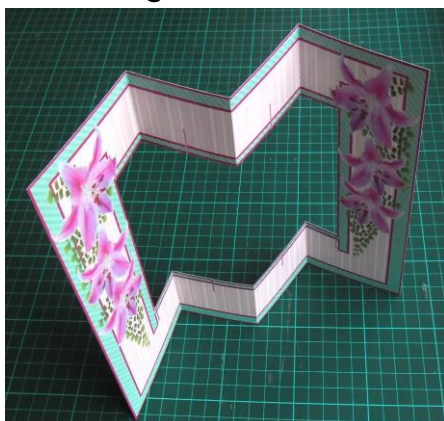


Main parts of the card

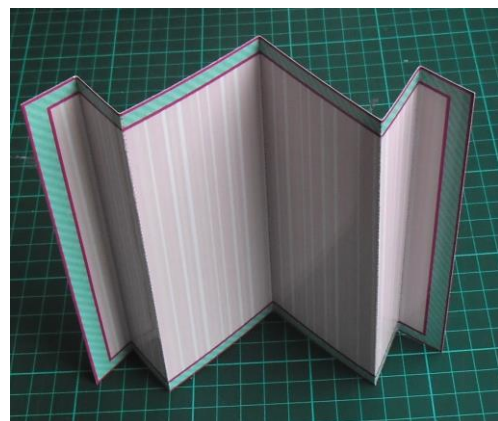


oval layers

3. Layer up the shapes using sticky foam pads and put them to one side.
4. Score along the dotted lines on the main card and the inside concertina.
5. Cut along the solid lines on the main card.



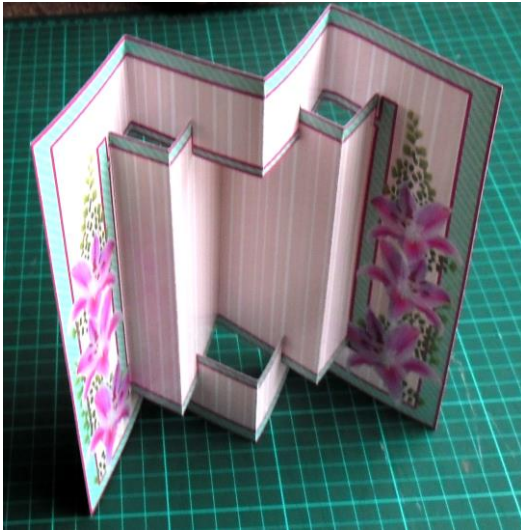
How to fold the main card



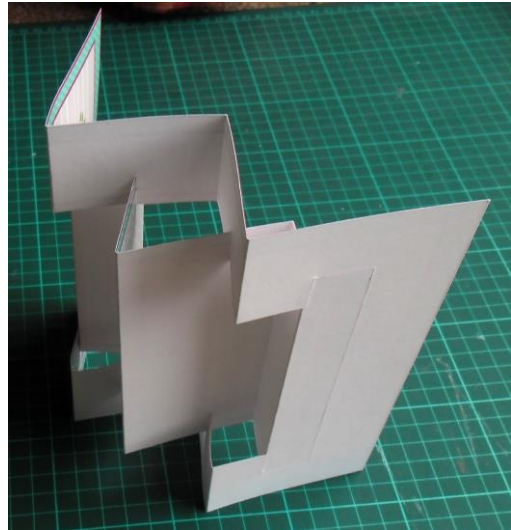
How to fold the inside concertina

6. Fold the pieces like the diagrams above.

7. Insert the inside concertina piece into the main card.

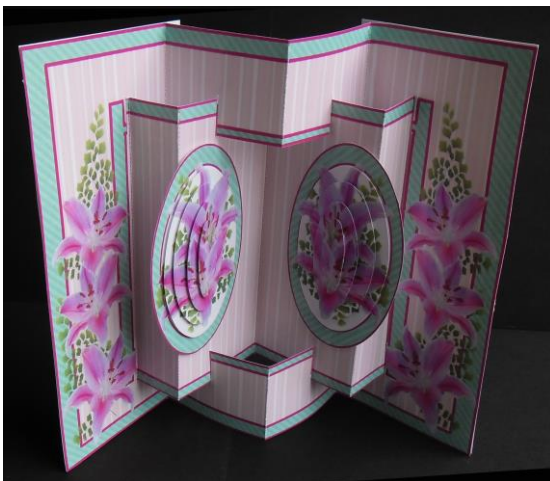


This diagram show how the pieces fit together.



This is the back of the card showing where the edges are stuck down to the back.

8. Fold the card a couple of times so it goes flat properly before sticking the edges on the back of the card.



9. Stick the oval images in place making sure that they don't stick out when the card is folded flat.



10. Make up the front layers using sticky foam pads and stick in place. Also stick the back panel in place but this is optional.

11. When the back and front are stuck in place they stick out past the edges on the back. This is so they cover the card completely when it is folded shut.
