

**Instructions to make card with a square aperture
(and layered pyramid)**

If the design has dark colours or black print onto card NOT photo paper to avoid smudges.

Print out :-

Card front Card back – you have a choice of 2, one of them uses less ink.
 Card middle You only need one of them.
 Layer sheet (with labels)

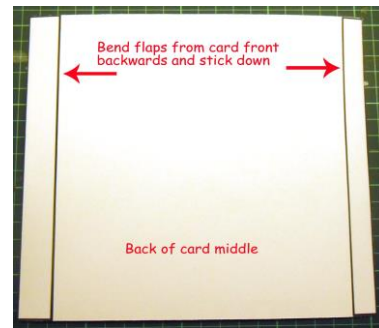

1. Cut out all pieces shown in fig 1. The card front will need to be cut along line A and scored and folded along lines B & C (marked on the printout).
2. Cut out the aperture in the card front.
3. Place the 2 pieces of card front face down, place the card middle on top (face down).
4. Bend the flaps towards you and stick down on the back of the card middle.(fig2)

5. Stick on the back (fig 3). The one you have chosen to use.
6. Turn the card over to face you (fig4).
7. You have a choice;- you can stick the right hand part of the front down or you can leave it open. An extra fancy shape has been included in case you want to use it inside this part of the front.
7. Stick on the layer shapes using sticky foam pads or silicone glue.
8. Close the card, the layer shapes will appear through the aperture in the front.



Stick on your chosen sentiment label.
