How To Make a Double Fold Card

1. Print out the design sheets according to the instructions on each sheet - i.e. onto paper or card.



Cut out each piece - making a note of which numbered piece is from the background sheet. (I suggest lightly writing the piece's number on the back in pencil).

3. Score and fold the main base card and the mini card along the dotted





lines. At this stage I added some gold peel offs around the border of the larger section of the card. (You could ink around the edges instead.)



Using double sided tape, stick background piece 1 onto the centre of the large main card base. Repeat on the back of this main card base with background piece 2. (So the back of the card is pretty too.)



Fold over the small right side of the base card and stick background piece 4 onto it's centre. On my sample I added border peel offs.



Put double sided tape onto the back of the mini card.

Adhere it to the centre of the main base card, with it's opening on the right.



The flap on the right of the card tucks inside the mini card. Stick background piece 3 onto the centre of the front of the mini card.

Stick the topper onto the centre of this. (For my sample I used pearlised card as my topper).



Using foam pads or silicon glue, stick on any decoupage in the kit. (Some cards don't have decoupage).



This is the card standing up with the folds opened up fully to show you how they fit together.
