

Start by cutting out all elements. I like to back the central spring out element onto some scrap card before cutting out to prevent any curling. Glue panel 1 to the reverse of the central section of the insert



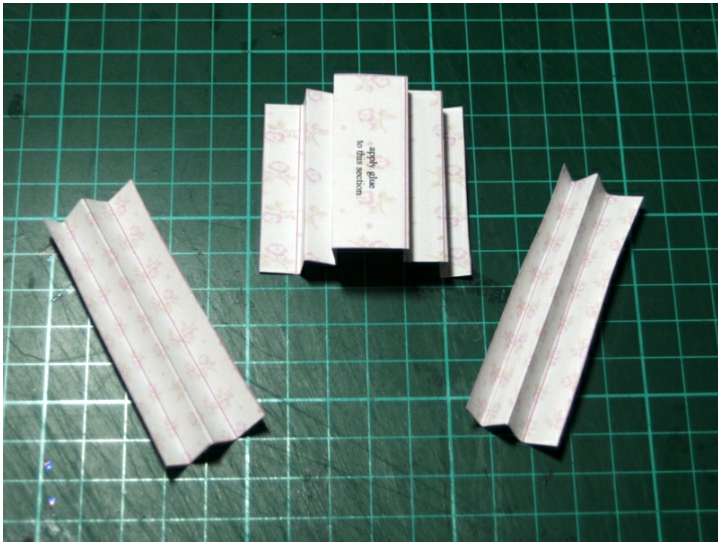
Glue panel 2 to the reverse of the back greetings panel



Cut out the white area for the aperture on the insert, then score and valley fold the end panels.



Glue the card front panels in place.



Score and fold the central spring and the two side gussets as indicated.



Apply glue to one of the end sections as indicated on each of the side gussets and fix to the reverse of the card insert



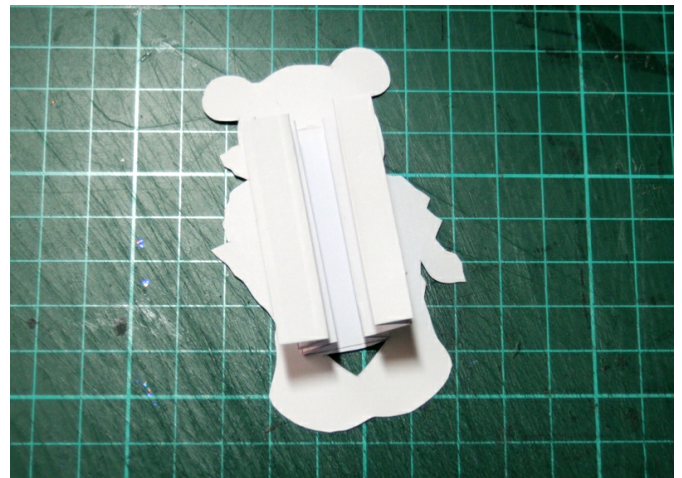
Then apply glue to the other end sections of the side gussets and fix the back greeting panel in place centrally.

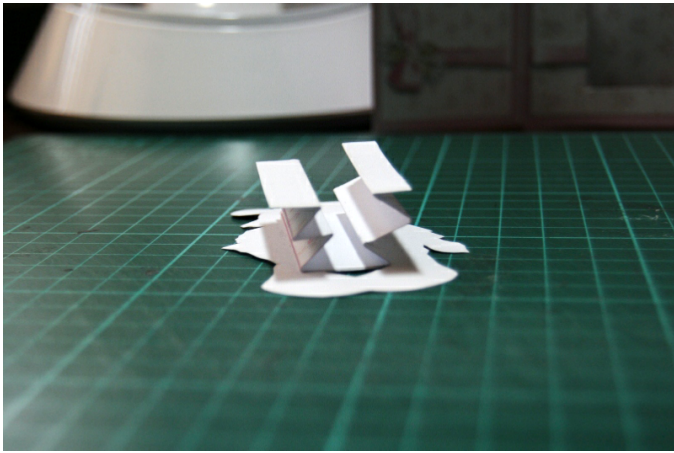


View from top of card



Apply glue to the middle section of the central spring and fix this to the back of the central spring element.

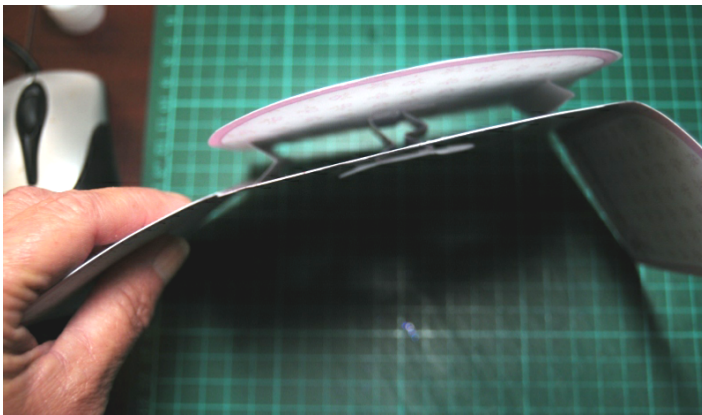




The central spring element will look like this at the back



Apply glue to the top end sections of the central spring and fix the bear centrally in the aperture of the card



The card will now look like this if you look down from the top

Now just add the sentiment of your choice and the decoupage and your card is complete
