
Cute small and tiny milk carton style boxes in the shpe of a gingerbread house an extra bonus sheet is included with inners to hold a cupcake in place or if you leave this out they make great little boxes to hold sweets/ cookies or small gifts too! The tiny gingerbread house makes a great



For best results print sheets 1 to 4 onto photo paper or good quality cardstock. Print sheet 5 onto the reverse for a pretty lining




for both boxes
before cutting out use a ruler
and scoring tool to score the
fold lines on sheets where
marked including between the
small black dots. I have marked
these in red on the diagram



Cut out all pieces.

Fold and crease all score lines using a bone folder.

The red lines denote mountain folds and the blue lines valley folds, cut the green lines.



score and fold the small box as per the diagram on the left and the box inserts as per the right diagram

The front of the large box will now look like this.

Add double sided tape to the side flaps. I have marked these in red on the photo



The front of the large box will now look like this



The easiest way to crease the diagonal valley folds is to turn over the triangular piece on the right and crease



... and then fold over and crease the other triangle piece, making sure not to crease down into the sides of the box.



Join the front and back of your box making sure to align the sides.









To make things easier for you to see I haven't printed the backing paper onto the reverse of my sheets.

Your box will now look like this. Add double sided tape to the bottom and side flaps.

I have marked these in red on the photo.

Fold your box in half and adhere to the double sided tape we added earlier. making sure to line up the sides

Open out and turn your box on it's side. Fold in the 2 opposite smaller bottom flaps. Making sure to keep your box square.

Fold in the remaining smaller flap



Fold up and and adhere the remaining flap to secure the base of your box



Your box will now look like this from the front



Your box will now look like this from the side



Fold over the top flap from the rear of your box. Punch holes where marked and secure with ribbon or cord.

The tiny box is made in exactly the same way following the instructions from the top of page 4 in this tutorial



I finished my boxes off with ribbon, pom poms for berries on the holly from the kit, a small tag and lots of glitter. I added a hanging loop to the small box to hang it from the Christmas tree.





They are great filled with a cupcake, gift, treat or sweets!! There are cupcake and small treat inserts on sheet 4 of the kit. Score, fold, cut out the cenre (choosing the size you require on the smaller one) and insert them into the boxes.
