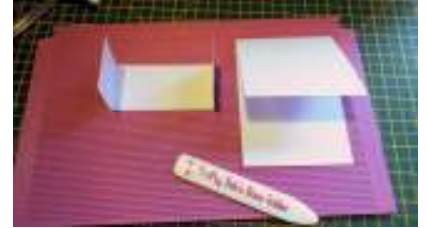


HOW TO MAKE A DUTCH FOLD CARD

1. Print out Page 1 onto white card.
2. Print out the toppers and decoupage onto smooth white card or photo paper.
3. Cut out each piece.
4. Score and fold the main card body and small wrap.



5. Put adhesive on rear of the main card at the bottom. It is important to glue this piece and not the wrap because it is narrower than the wrap to ensure that the wrap folds easily around the card. (I found glue worked better than double sided tape because of the next step). Match the bottom edge of the wrap and the bottom edge of the main card, with the card on top of the wrap. Stick the card centrally onto the wrap.



6. Flip the card over, and stick the topper onto the smaller section of the main card. This will be the front of your card. Stick the optional back cover onto your card at this stage.



7. Flip the card back over and stick the toppers on the inside flaps of the wrap and the large inner topper on the inside of the card.



8. Flip over again, and stick the toppers onto the outside of the flaps of the wrap.



9. Make up the main topper for the card, and any decoupage, using silicon glue or foam pads. Fold the card as if you were going to post it, and position the main topper on the front flap, making sure that it does not have any adhesive which might stick it to the small flaps. See the next page photos to see roughly where to place it.
