A fabulous set of keepsake drawers with mini cards, inserts, envelope notepaper, gift tags and toppers and it's really easy to make too!





Print all the sheets, printing as many cards and envelopes as you require. Before cutting out use a ruler and scoring tool to score all the fold line.

Cut out all the pieces, also cut

Cut out all the pieces. also cut the 4 cut lines on sheet 1 drawer to create the glue flaps.




pre fold and crease the score lines on all the sheets



Start with Sheet 1 drawer.

fold over the flap with the circle and cut out



Turn over and fold in the glue flaps.


Add double sided glue or tape where shown in red on the photo onto the printed side of the glue flaps and onto the unprinted side of the side flaps



Fold over and stick down the sides that have the glue flaps




Fold up the remaining sides adhering using the glue flaps and making sure the corners line up




Your drawer will now look like this

fold over and stick down the remaining two side flaps





Your drawer is now complete and will look like this



Now we'll work with sheet 2 drawer sleeve. 2 of the side flaps have straight edges and 2 have angled ones.

I have marked where these are in red for the straight ones and green for the angled ones.


Make sure you note where the straight and angled flaps are for the next few steps

Turn over and add double sided tape to the unprinted side of the glue flaps.


Add double sided tape where marked in orange on the photo




Fold over and stick down the two end flaps




Fold in the 2 side flaps with the angled edges



Lift up the side of the sleeve with the angled edges, keeping the glue flaps on the outside



Stick the glue flap onto the outside of the sleeve side, making sure the corner is square




look like this with the angled edges to the right and the glue flap on the outside.


Do not be tempted to put the glue flaps on the inside as this will stop your drawer from sliding correctly. The glue flaps

will be hidden in the next step

Your drawer sleeve will now



Fold over the remaining side of the sleeve and stick into place on the outside of the glue flap, lining up the corners and the front edges.



Your drawer sleeve is now complete



and your drawer will now slip inside



Print, score, cut out, and fold your mini cards and gift cards.
Print and trim the inserts.
These are slightly oversided to allow you to trim using a deckle or scalloped edge trimmer or scissors



Cut out the toppers, print cut out and make up the envelopes. Print and cut out as many notepaper squares as you require.

The drawer will hold 8 cards and matching envelopes or alternatively fill with the notepaper squares instead.



Your drawer set can be finished in lots of ways. topped with one of the toppers, filled with cards or notepaper or tied with a ribbon. They make great gift sets and would be great sellers for Craft Fayres etc



Or why not make two or more sets of drawers and stick the two together, tie with a ribbon and fill with cards, envelopes and notepaper, or small treats!


