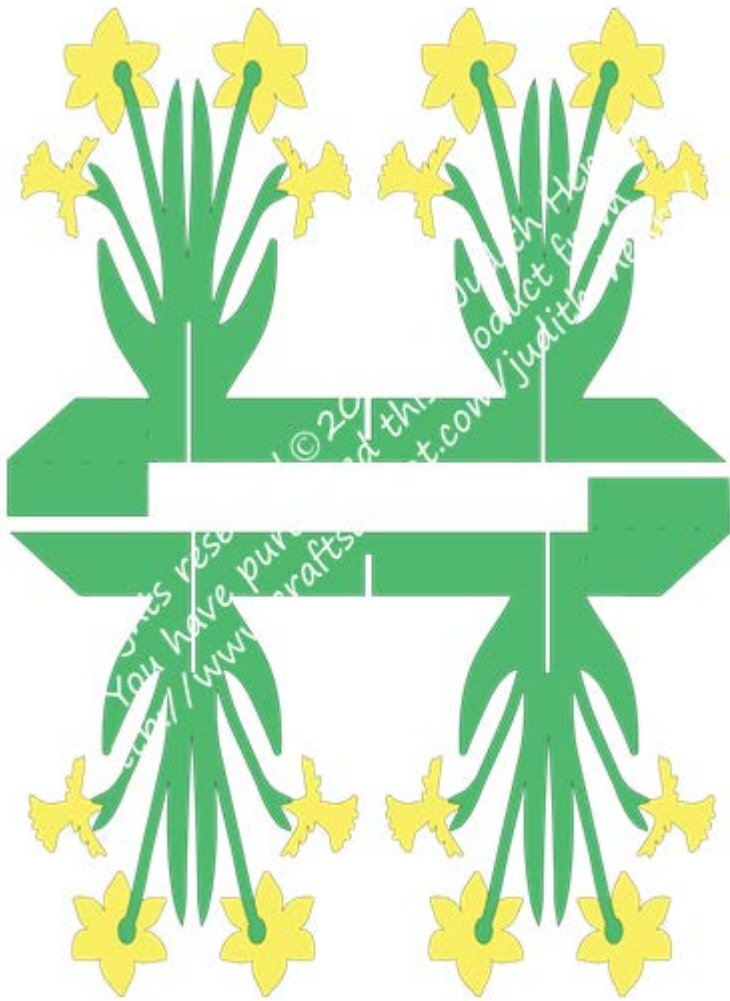


Daffodil Slice Form Popup



Recommended materials:

1. Light weight green card stock
2. Medium weight yellow card stock
3. Medium weight card stock for folder
4. Glue pen such as Zig Memory system 2 way glue
5. Double sided adhesive tape
6. Patience

Cutting and Assembly Instructions

Start with the daffodil pieces. As delivered, the flower is in place to show where they are glued. You will need to separate them and cut one of each on this page. The stems will be cut twice. The flower and stems are assembled as a sandwich. The daffodils are inserted between the two green pieces.

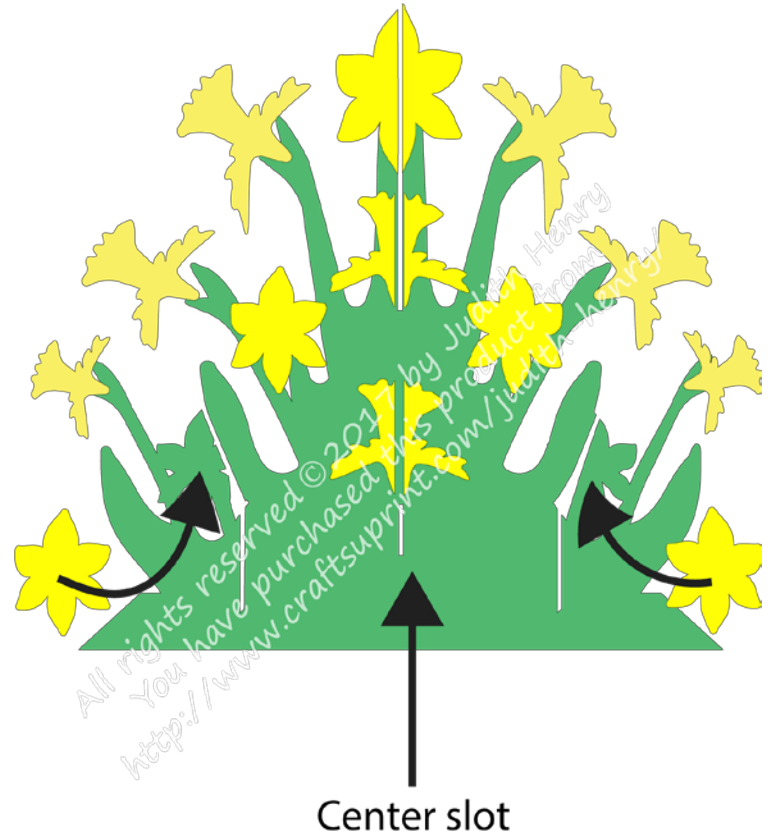
The easiest way to assemble these would be to leave one copy on the cutting mat. Use the glue pen to attach the flower. Once dried the matching base piece can be glued over the piece. Be careful to not glue shut the slit areas.

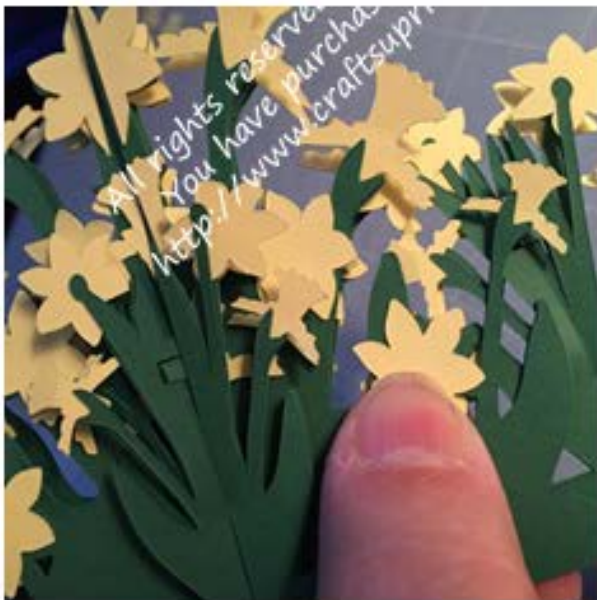


The center pieces are assembled in the same manner as instructed on the previous page with the exception of cutting the bright lemon yellow pieces twice. These are added to both sides. The two marked with arrows are added after assembly since they cover the slot and help hold the slice form together.

The split pieces align to either side of the slit and form a spacing for the pieces to fit together.

Cut the pieces for the card base. The main card piece is not included. Cut a piece of card stock 5.5 x 11 inches. Score the center, fold and crease.



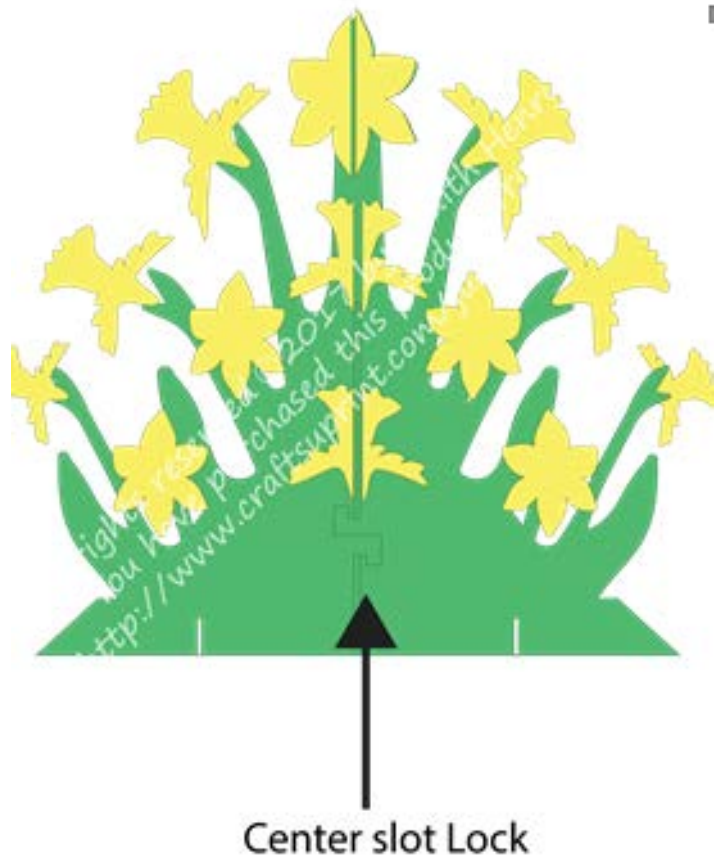


Start assembling the slice form.

The smaller daffodil pieces slide together at the notches down the center of the flower pieces. The upward sliding piece has locking notch. It stabilizes the corner above the leaves.

Two corners have tabs that will slide into the base and makes the form fold up.

You have a square form with one center piece. The last center piece slides down the middle and locks in place at the center slot.



The last step is to assemble the card folder and attach the slice form by slipping the tabs through the slits and gluing them down. Sandwich all the pieces together and embellish with a verse and other items.
