

Twist & Popup Template

Cutting & Assembly Instructions

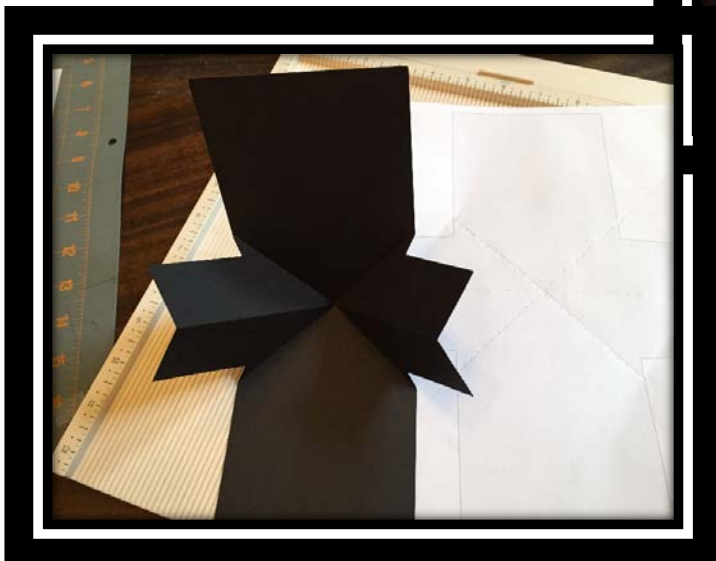


The tutorial is for cup823647_2228 - Sassy Cheryl - Halloween Twist & Popup Card. This card comes with two derivations of Sassy Cheryl digital stamps, A Jolly Good Halloween and Too Cute To Spook. These are provided as a print and cut pdf format under my commercial license. This is sold to you as a Personal use only. To make the card for resell you will need a Sassy Cheryl commercial license.

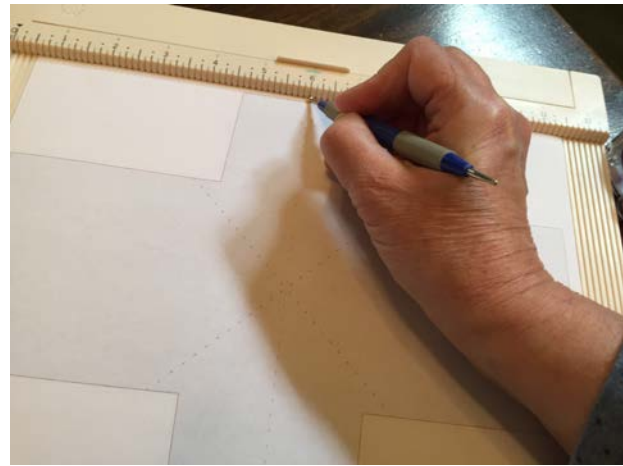
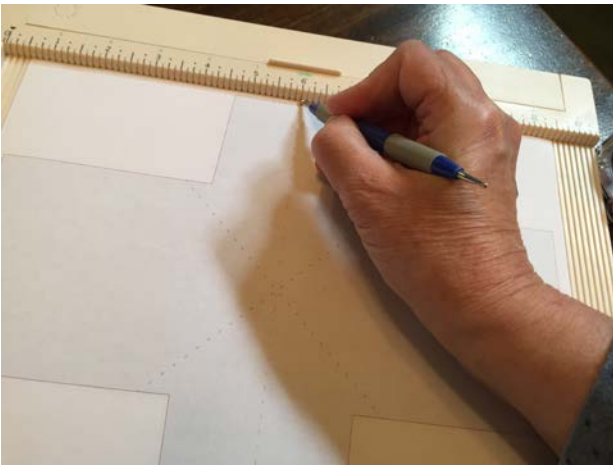
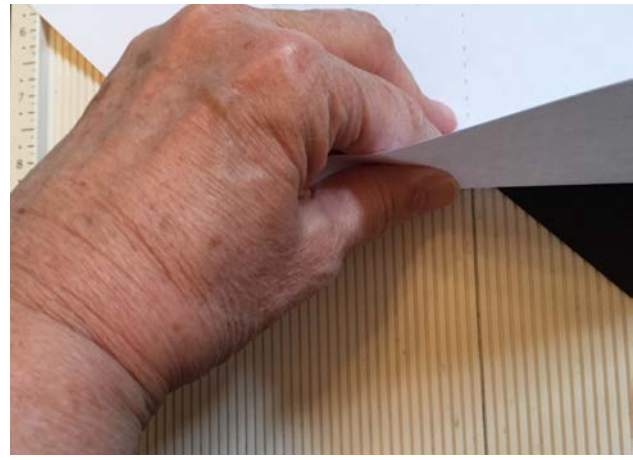
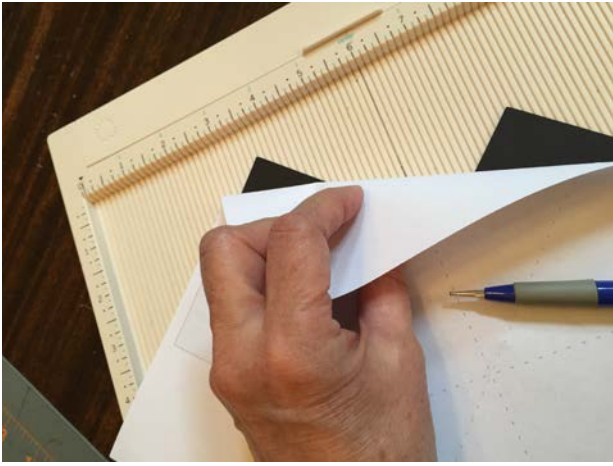
Print the SC_HalloweenTwist&PopUp_PrintAndCut_BW.pdf or the colored version of the digital stamp. The Black and White version is provided for you to add your own personal coloring.

There is a file that matches the print and cut to cut the card objects. The front cover piece needs to be trimmed by .25 inch to fit the zigzag frame. I also cut a few extra small bats by scaling to use as embellishments. Use scrapbook paper as much as possible to keep the thickness of the card to a minimum. The Black pieces are cut from card stock.

Start by assembling the inside twist mechanism. Since it is cut from black cardstock it is difficult to see the score lines. I print out the form on white paper to lay over the cardstock and use a score board to make the folds. I also mark the 6 inch measurement down the board so I can match the diagonal angles.



Once scored follow the folding making Red lines as valley folds and Blue lines as mountain folds.



Nest the digital stamps in their frame. Use adhesive to attach each piece to the twist mechanism.

Use the decorative accent piece as a frame for the mechanism. Attach to the mechanism with adhesive only on the top and bottom. Cut an A-2 card base (4.25 x 11) from cardstock. Score and fold in half. Again attach to the mechanism only at the top and bottom.



Make the front of the card. Oops! Looks like the digital stamp piece is .25 inch too long. Trim and mount the nested pieces to the card base. Perhaps you would like to add one of those small bats embellishments somewhere.



All that is left is the popup piece. It is a long piece that needs to be scored and folded to make a W. Attach the background piece to each section, fold the big bat and place the fold on the mountain fold. I did not make my fold in the middle. It gave is a wonky flying bat. Make sure to fold the bat wing tips at the other folds and glue it down. The ghosts go on the two end pieces.





The twist mechanism need adhesive applied in the opposite folded sides in a square formation. The bat/ghost strip is centered horizontally and attached to these areas and will overlap the end. Notice that the end folds are lined up with the edge of the card. Gently close the card and watch the insert fold inwards.
