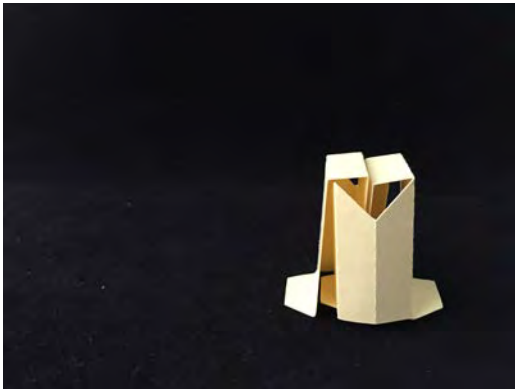


Dragonfly Mechanism



This is the hardest piece to explain. It is two identical pieces that nest together to form a center leg wrapped in a box structure with 4 gluing tabs.

Follow the cutting fold lines. There is only one mountain fold. Make sure to set the crease.



Line the two pieces up as pictured. The two center pieces will be glued together with the foot tabs facing in opposite directions. This picture is with the pieces glued and upside down.



The end tabs wrap around the center leg with two glue tabs to make the box.

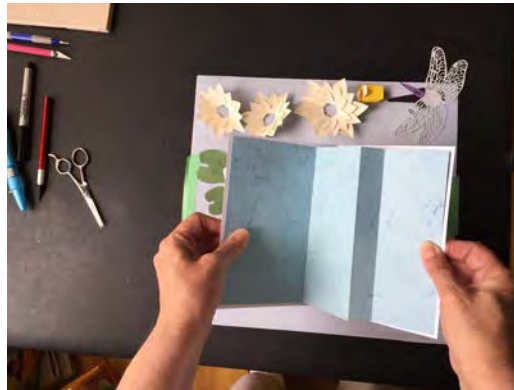


Left picture is upside down. Second is right side up with the center seam lining up with the fold.

Inside Base Assembly



Set the folds with the folding bone. The large fold is on the left. The two valley folds will be the area to put the pop up elements (Dragonfly and lilies)

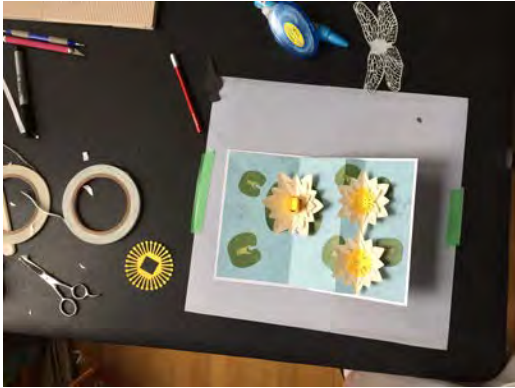


Tape the edges in the two places indicated. Attach to the front cover so the panels do not move when folded. There should be 1/8 inch border from the front cover.

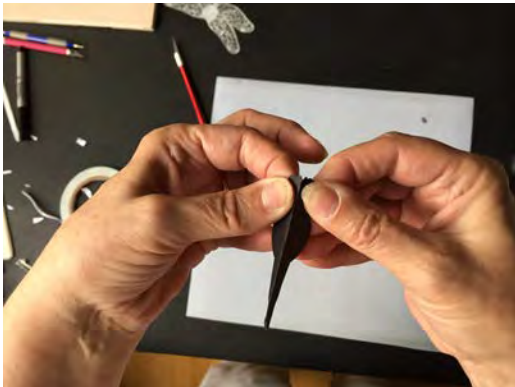


Glue the lily pads to the inside. The largest goes over the left fold. Make sure to fold is before gluing to the inside.

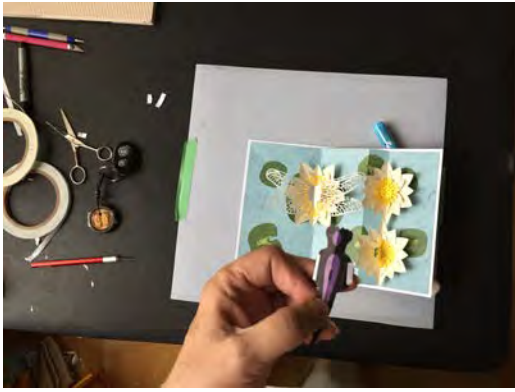
The center post of the mechanism will go over the valley crease of the large lily pad.



The large lily may need to be trimmed to go around the pop up mechanism. The triangle tabs should be glued to the base. Add the rest of the lilies and lily pads. Put the correct stem in each flower



The dragonfly has three mountain folds. The circular tabs are attached to the wings pointing towards the center fold. This raises the body. Use extra strong glue as this area get a lot of movement.



Add your choice of color to the back of the dragonfly, glue the wings in place and glue the body to the wings. The card is finished.
