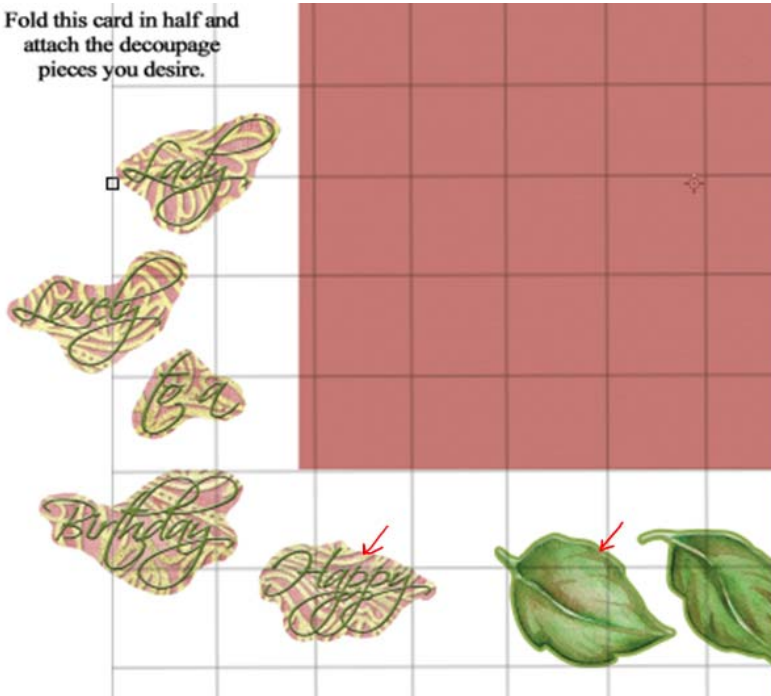


Helpful Hints for assembling cards from SuzieQ Kuttables Sold Exclusively at www.craftsuprint.com/sue-ric

Fold this card in half and attach the decoupage pieces you desire.



I've started adding an extra wide borders so you can cut the decoupage pieces as close or as far as you desire. It also serves to help any white paper from showing due to not cutting the piece exactly. See the red arrows for an example of the extra large borders. You would cut this border off.



Fold the card in half by butting it up against something like this score board. It is easy to get it exactly squared up and in half when you have two square corners to work with.

Using a bone folder to make the center crease can sometimes damage the paper. Turn the folded card upside down, place a piece of paper over the card and then use your bone folder to make the crease. This way you can press quite hard to get a great fold.



When applying decoupage pieces use a tweezers to line it up. This helps by not getting your fingers in the way of your vision and it is easier to not get it crooked.



This is the card used in this tutorial. It is called Happy Birthday Lady 1
