



A Make Me project from MJM Design Studios #workshopinazipfile

1. Print off the sheets taking note of the pages that are double sided as marked!
 Page 3 is double sided with page 4 (the purple 2 M's)
 Page 5 (or the alternative letters page 15 or 17) is double sided with page 6 (u, o or a)
 Page 7 is double sided with page 8 (the pink 2 M's)
 Page 9 (or the alternative letters page 16 or 18) is double sided with page 10 (u, o or a)
 I printed all of my project on 200gsm cardstock



2. Cut out your letters. Make sure you keep the joining tabs on the purple letters.
 Lay the purple letters out as in the picture with the tab of the M on the right going to the centre. Score all the tab lines on the purple letters, fold and score.



3. Turn the purple letters over, keeping them in the same line up (you will now see the M on the right has it's tab on the outside edge) and adhere the tabs on either side of your central letter (u, o or a) to the two M's making sure the fold is exactly lined up with the edge of the letter



4. Concertina your letters up starting with the tab on the leading edge folding backwards.



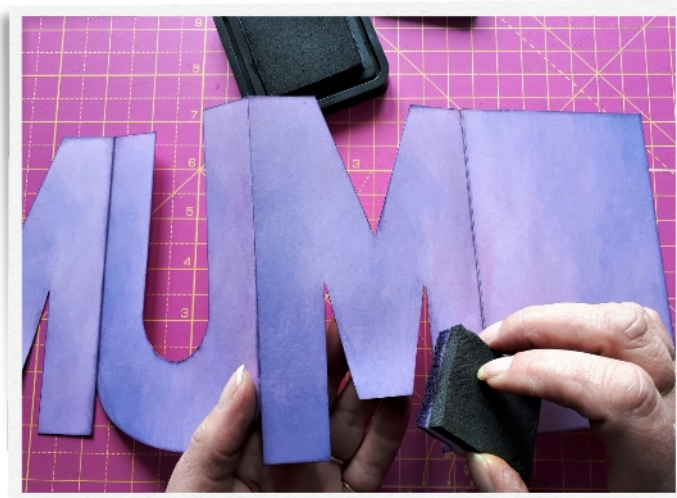
5. Lay your now joined letters down flat with the purple side facing you and adhere the purple back of the front cover to the M on the right, lining up the edge of the cover to the fold in the tab and then adhere the purple back of the back cover to the M at the other end.



6. Turn the whole thing over again so the pink side of the letters are facing and attach the pink front of the front cover to the M now on the left, again make sure to line it up to the fold of the tab and make sure you adhere it well to the back cover piece.



7. Then adhere the pink side of the back cover into place at the other end.



8. Ink the edges of the covers and the letters to take away the white core of the card showing and to create definition of the letters, do this on both the purple and pink side.



9. Time to decorate the front cover. I cut out some of the elements from the front cover sheet, inking edges, layering and shaping elements and I also added some flowers, lace and pearls from my stash to add some different texture. I used a glitter pen to trace over the word and to add a bit of sparkle to the butterfly. How you decorate yours is up to you.



10. Now it's time to decorate the front of the letters. It is easier to do this before they are attached. Ink all the edges of the letters. I cut out the embellishments from the sheets, and kept them the same for each letter to create a continuity with the project and I also added a little of the lace I used on the front cover for the same reason as well as to add a little texture and interest. I added some dimension to the flowers by cutting out the centres from another and layering them up, shaping them and inking the edges of all the elements lightly to hide the card stocks white core.



IMPORTANT! Make sure the elements don't go over the right and left edges of the letters as it will stop the project folding!



11. Once your letters are decorated adhere them to the pink side of the base of your card. **IMPORTANT!** Centre each letter leaving a little gap either side to keep the fold of your card free.



12. Assemble the box, the print out shows where to cut away the triangles on the corners and where to score. Once you have adhered all the tabs and constructed the box decorate the top as you wish. I added some of the embellishments from sheet to build up the flowers and added the butterflies with sparkle and dimension.
