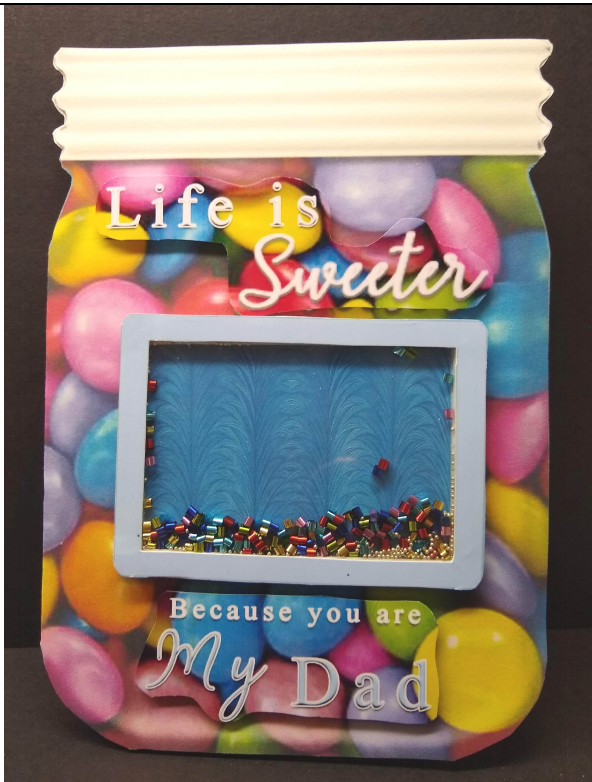


Shaker Cards by SuzieQ Kuttables

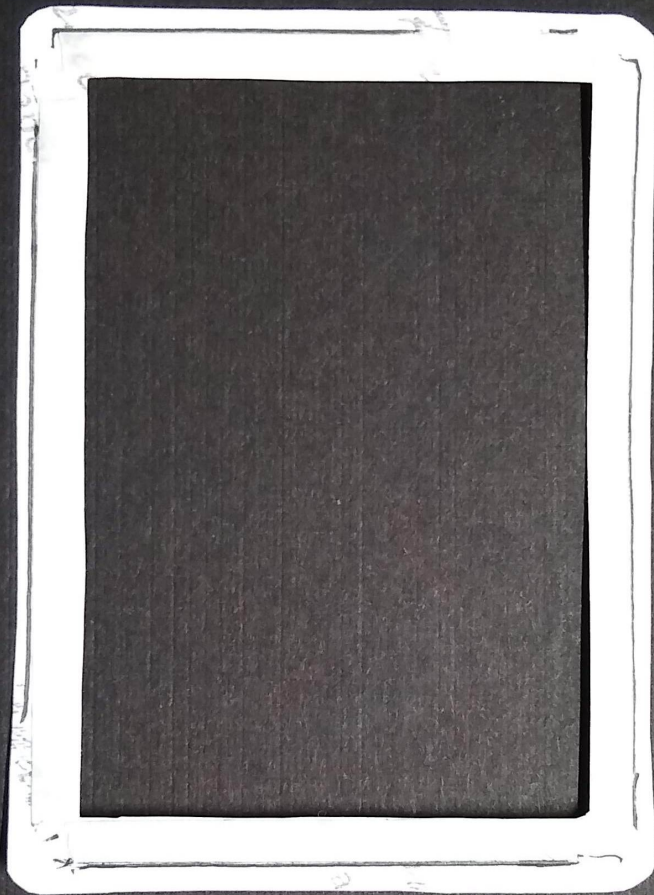
This tutorial is using my design Candy Jar Shaker Card



The finished card.

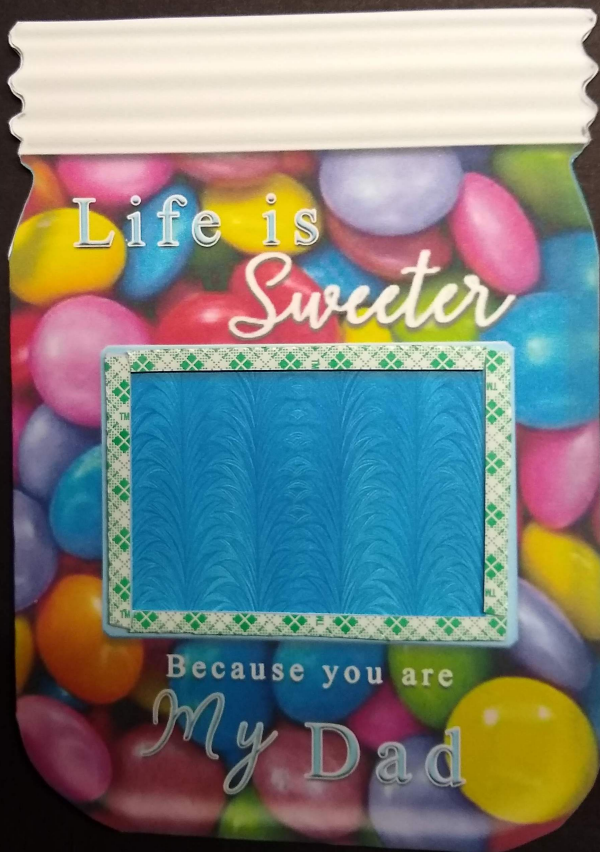


Cut out the frame and a piece of acetate that is slightly smaller than the frame, but larger than the middle hole in the frame.

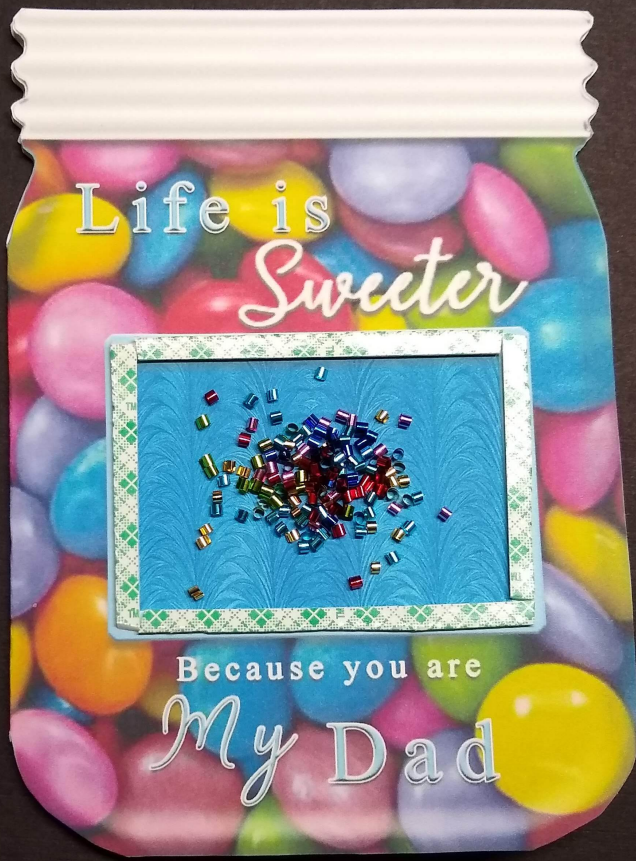


Apply double sided tape as close to the inside edge as possible without going over the edge. Because the tape is hard to see, I drew a line around it to show where the outside edge of the tape is. The inside edge is on the inside cut line of the frame without going over the edge.

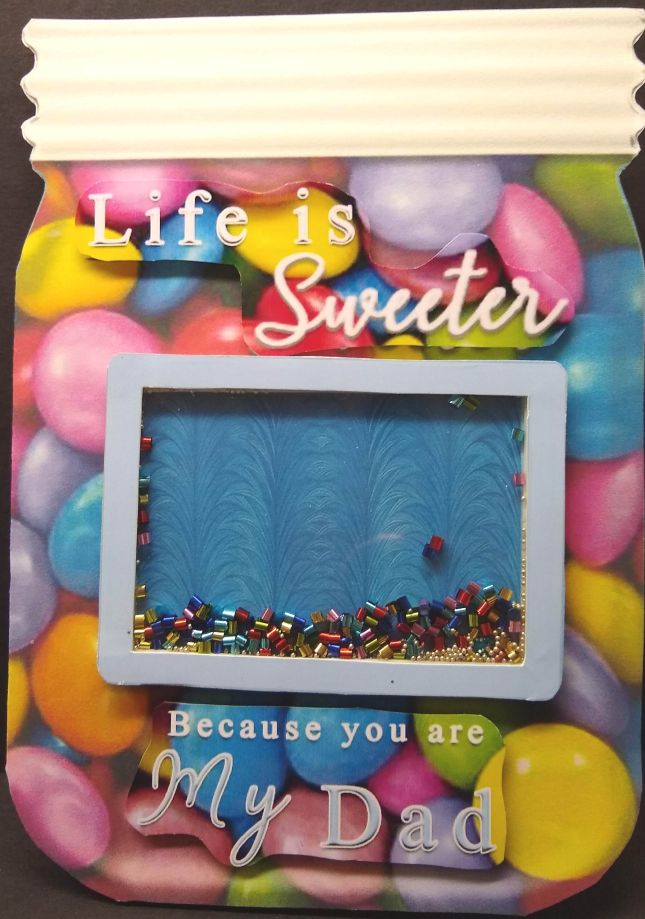
Remove the protective strip and attach the acetate to the frame.



Directly on the card attach 3D foam tape. I made two layers of the foam tape to make sure the shaker bits have enough room to move when the card is shook. So you would remove the backing from the first layer than apply a second layer on top of the first layer. Make sure the ends butt up closely to each other so none of the shaker bits shake out. Do not remove the protective strip yet.



Add your shaker bits then remove the protective strip.



Carefully attach the frame to the 3D foam tape.
