Is it a Box or is it a Bag?
Really easy to make and suprisingly strong it's a combination of both!




For best results print sheets onto photo paper or good quality cardstock.



Before cutting out use a ruler and scoring tool to score the fold lines on sheets where marked.

The red, partial, score registration lines are for the box sides. I have marked them in red on the photo.



Cut out all pieces.

Fold and crease all score lines using a bone folder.

The red lines denote mountain folds and the blue lines valley folds



This step is optional but I found it gave better results to pierce a small hole at the points of the triangle folds on the sides.

I have marked them in red on the photo



Once you have folded and creased it will look like this from the side. If you have problems folding and creasing the partial folds this can be done by pinching the edges firmly together.

Complete both sides in the same way



Place the front and back side by side and add double sided tape where marked in blue on the photo



Join the front to the back



Turn over and fold in the side. I have marked in blue the place where the double sided tape that we added earlier is.



Fold the back over and adhere in place. Doing it this way will ensure your box is totally square.



Stand the box up and turn upside down. Fold in the 2 flaps we added double sided tape to earlier. I have marked them in blue on the photo



Fold down the base and tuck in the long flap making sure all edges adhere to complete the base of the box



Turn the right way up and add a gift to your box.

It's surprisingly roomy!



Pinch the sides of your box together at the top and fold down the flap



I am sealing my bag with a clear parcel seal, but you could use Sellotape, Velcro dots or magnets etc if wished.



There are tags and decoupage in the kits too.

I wrote a greeting on the reverse of my tag.



Add the tag and the decoupage wherever you would like.



I also crystals to my flower and a second flower on the front of the bag too
